




### School Performance in 2019 comparing pupil groups




The number of pupils in Worcestershire achieving a Good Level of Development (GLD) at the end of reception in 2019 was 71.9%, which is an increase of 0.7% compared to 2018 performance. This improvement in performance has taken us in line with National, where pupils achieving GLD increased from 71.7% to 71.8%. 71.1% of pupils in Worcestershire achieved at least the expected level across all ELGs in 2019, which is an increase of 1.1% compared to 2018 and is now slightly above the national figure (70.7%). In 2019, Girls in Worcestershire achieving at least the expected standard across all ELGs decreased from 78.5% to 77.0% taking us just below the national figure of 77.6%, where as boys performance increased from 62.1% to 65.3%, above the national figure of 64.0%. Please note - 2018 and 2019 EYFSP National data provided below is for state-funded schools (not including Private, Voluntary and Independent schools) obtained from NCER using data from most local authorities in England and therefore may differ slightly to National published figures.



School Performance compared to Worcestershire and National - Pupil Groups - 2019





The number of pupils in Worcestershire exceeding in all early learning goals at the end of reception in 2019 was 2.6%, which is an increase of 0.4% compared to 2018 performance but remains below national performance of 2.9%. 3.6% of girls in Worcestershire were exceeding the standard across all ELG's in 2019 compared to 3.9% of girls nationally. 1.6% of boys in Worcestershire were exceeding in all ELG's, compared to 2.0% of boys nationally. Pupils in Worcestershire who are eligible for Free School Meals or whose first language is that other than English are less likely than National to be exceeding in all ELG's. (0.4% of FSM pupils locally compared to 1.2% nationally, and 0.7% EAL pupils locally compared to 2.5% nationally). Conversely, pupils in Worcestershire with a SEND statement, receiving support or have a EHCP were slightly more likely than national to be exceeding in all ELG's. Please note - 2018 and 2019 EYFSP National data provided below is for state-funded schools (not including Private, Voluntary and Independent schools) obtained from NCER using data from most local authorities in England and therefore may differ slightly to National published figures.



Percentage of pupils meeting the expected standard of phonic decoding by the end of year 2 - 2019



In 2019, 82% of pupils in Worcestershire reached the expected standard of phonic decoding at the end of Year 1. This is a slight decrease on performance from the previous year but remains in line with the national figure (81.8%). Pupils who did not take the check in year 1 or who did not reach the expected standard usually take the check in year 2. 91.4% of Year 2 pupils in Worcestershire reached the expected standard during either Year 1 or Year 2. Again, this is a slight decrease on performance in 2018 but remains in line with the national figure (91.3%). 81.0% of pupils in Worcestershire who are eligible for FSM achieved the expected standard by the end of Year 2, this is an increase of 0.8% compared to 2018 but remains below national (83.8%). The gap in performance for pupils in Worcestershire who are eligible for FSM has decreased from 13.2% (in 2018) to 11.9% at the end of Year 2 in 2019. This narrowing gap has also been seen nationally from 9.4% to 9.0%.

In 2019, the percentage of children in Worcestershire to have reached the expected standard in reading, writing and maths at the end of KS1 is 64.9%. This is a decrease of 0.7% compared to 2018 performance but remains in line with national (64.9%).

Writing appears to be our weakest subject with 69% of pupils in Worcestershire achieving the expected standard (a decrease of 1.7% from 2018) but is close to the national figure of 69.2%.


Girls (both in Worcestershire and nationally) remain more likely than boys to have reached the expected standard at the end of KS1 in 2019. This is the case for each of reading, writing and maths. However, boys are more likely than girls to be working at greater depth in maths.

42.9% of pupils in Worcestershire who are eligible for free school meals achieved the expected standard. This is a decrease from 43.7% in 2018 and has taken us to 5.6% below national.

11.7% of pupils in Worcestershire were deemed to be working at greater depth at the end of KS1 in 2019 in reading, writing and maths. Worcestershire has remained above national for three consecutive years, however the decrease in performance of 1.2% compared to 2018 has brought us close to national where previously we were 1.2% above. The percentage of girls in Worcestershire achieving a greater depth in reading, writing and maths has decreased 2.0% from 15.2% to 13.2% in 2019. This compares to a 0.5% decrease nationally. Boys in Worcestershire achieving greater depth in reading, writing and maths has remained consistent and has been above national for the last three years.
